## WORLD DAY OF PRAYER

World Day of Prayer is a worldwide movement of Christian Women who come together to observe a common day of prayer each year and who in many countries have a continuing relationship in prayer and service. This celebration will be held the first Friday in March. This year the WDP in Duncan will be held at the first Christian Church 912 W. Walnut at 9:30 a.m. on Friday, March 7, 2014. Everyone is welcome.

WDP materials for 2014 were prepared by the WDP committee of Egypt and is titled "Streams In The Desert". The religious mosaic of Egypt is about 90% Muslim (mostly Sunni); about 10% Christian (mostly Coptic Orthodox, but also Protestant and Catholic) and a few thousand Egyptian Jews. The first missionary to Egypt was Peter Heyling (1633-1634) who spread the doctrine of the Evangelical Lutheran Church. The local Pasha had him beheaded because they suspected him of being a spy. In the seventh century AD, because of the Arab invasion of Egypt, many Egyptians have adopted the religion of the new rulers. The nineteenth century saw many Christian missionaries from various parts of the world come into Egypt.

These and many other interesting facts will be revealed when the women of FCC present their program on March 7.

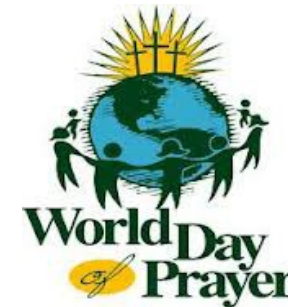
