## CodeRED Weather Warning

The city of Duncan, Oklahoma has joined many other U.S. municipalities and county governments, taking steps to better safeguard lives and property. As a public safety service the city of Duncan has elected to provide residents with a limited **CodeRED Weather Warning** subscription at no cost.

**CodeRED Weather Warning** automatically calls subscribed citizens when severe weather (tornado, flash flood, and severe thunderstorm) warnings are issued by the National Weather Service. The **CodeRED Weather Warning** System calls only when warnings are issued and only if your address is in the path of the storm.

To subscribe to **CodeRED Weather Warning** log on to the city of Duncan website at [www.cityofduncan.com](http://www.cityofduncan.com) and follow the **CodeRED** link. If you do not have access to a computer, contact the city of Duncan at 255-2112 for other means of subscribing. If you live outside the Duncan area, contact your local government office to determine if **CodeRED Weather Warning** subscription is available in your area.
