



## VACCINATIONS

“Back-to-School” is an excellent time to remind people of ALL ages to check their vaccination records to identify needs. Usually we think of children needing immunizations in order to enter specific grades (Kindergarten, Seventh grade and college). However, adults should also be aware of their role in protecting themselves and to keep from infecting infants who are not old enough for their vaccinations, such as pertussis (whooping cough). The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention reported 9,964 cases of pertussis in the first six months of 2014—a 24% increase over the same time period in 2013. Their website states “infants are at their greatest risk for getting pertussis, developing severe complications and death”. Doting grandparents & great-grandparents need to be aware that they could cause severe illness and complications without intent. Please check the available handouts identifying recommended immunizations for children and adults.
