3rd Annual Fiesta in Fuqua

August 4, 2007, 9-12 Noon

The event is sponsored by Stephens County Health Dept. for families with children aged 2 months to 10 years. The event's purpose is to: increase the county's immunization rate; encourage physical fitness among children; and to strengthen family bonds.

Offerings include: free immunizations at the Blue Cross/Blue Shield Car-ing Van; outdoor games offered by various agencies; free lunch (hot dogs with all the trimmings plus beverages); free rides at Kiddieland; free dental screenings; free child ID kits; and bags filled with free school supplies.

How does it work? Upon entering the park, each child checks in at the student store to receive a grade-appropriate, color-coded card. The child will take the card to each game in which he/she participates and will have it validated afterwards. They then return the card to the student store to receive their grade-appropriate bag of school supplies.
